

Water withdrawal notification

Fishhook Lake – POD-41 – Registry #6093

Coastal GasLink is committed to creating an extraordinary legacy of safety and respect for all people, communities and the environment. As part of this commitment we are keeping our neighbours along the project route informed on construction activities. Please note the following information:

What: Water withdrawal for hydrostatic testing and general construction activities. The hose will be submerged as required and will not remain on site for the duration of the water withdrawal period.

When: Water withdrawal is expected to begin on August 15, 2022.

Where: The hose will be installed at Fishhook Lake at 54° 38' 36.48" N, 122° 35' 24.12" W along Construction Section 3. The nearby communities of McLeod Lake, Anzac, Bear Lake, and Summit Lake will be notified.

Expected Duration: Water withdrawal is expected to conclude on June 26, 2024.
