Please be advised of the following information regarding upcoming construction activity along the project route:

What: Open burning of vegetative matter such as non-merchantable trees, stumps, roots, shrubs, branches and other debris from regulatory approved clearing activities.

When: Expected to begin as early as October 10, 2019 and last until December 31, 2019.

Where: This activity is planned for the following locations along the project route. Please see enclosed map.

Potential Impact: Permits and authorizations are in place and will be done in compliance with the BC Open Burning Smoke Control Regulation, Forest Fire Prevention and Suppression Regulation, and the Wildfire Regulation. Safety and fire prevention plans are in place. All burning activities will be done in accordance with the project's Environmental Management Plan and will be carefully planned and monitored, including for air quality and emission.
