What: Stuart River Bridge de-commissioning and removal activities will be taking place in Section 4.


When: Beginning on November 29, 2021 construction activities will take place 24 hours per day and continue until completion on February 18, 2022.

Where: Removal activities will occur at KP 297 to KP 298 along the Stuart River. The nearest community of Fort St. James, B.C., is located approximately 47.5 kilometres southeast of this activity.

Expected Duration: November 29, 2021 through to February 18, 2022.

Potential Impact: Public access to this segment of the Stuart River via watercraft will be **restricted** at this time. Closures and disruptions will occur intermittently and there are no residences located within this immediate area. It is not expected that these activities will result in any detectable sound or vibration beyond the immediate work area.
