Be a good neighbour

At Coastal GasLink, being a good neighbour is at the heart of everything we do. Through our Hire & Buy Local program, we're working to create meaningful and lasting benefits for the communities near our operations. We aim to build and maintain trust to help ensure shared success by supporting local economies and fostering collaboration.

Creating opportunities for local communities and businesses

The Hire & Buy Local program is a structured and transparent approach to prioritizing both Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities near our projects in our employment hiring and business procurement practices. We aim to ensure these communities share in project benefits through meaningful employment and contracting opportunities, using a fair, consistent and measurable process.

Here's how we approach it:

Prioritization: We identify communities based on their proximity to the project ("Proximate," "Local," and "Regional") to guide how opportunities are prioritized. Proximate communities, being the most impacted, receive the highest priority.

Opportunities: Specific contracting opportunities, or Designated Services, are reserved exclusively for Indigenous from Proximate communities. Other contracting opportunities, known as Targeted Services, are prioritized for both Proximate and Local businesses.

Clear commitments: Major contractors working on our projects are required to develop and deliver on clear, measurable commitments for both local hiring and local sourcing. This includes specific commitments to employ individuals from Proximate and Local communities.

Fostering collaboration: We work closely with our major contractors, communities and businesses throughout the project lifecycle to maximize local participation and ensure accountability.

Contracting opportunities over the project lifecycle

Our Hire & Buy Local approach is integrated throughout the project.

- **Planning:** We identify impacted communities and establish the Designated and Targeted service opportunities. These Hire & Buy Local commitments are embedded into the selection process for major contractors.
- **Contractor engagement & procurement:** We facilitate introductions between selected major contractors and both Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities and businesses near our projects. Major contractors will engage these communities and businesses when sourcing for Designated and Targeted services.
- **Construction:** We continuously monitor contractors' performance against their Hire & Buy Local commitments for local hiring and procurement. Most hiring opportunities arise during this phase, typically including roles like equipment operators, skilled trades, laborers and administrative support. Hiring for these roles is primarily done by the major contractor and their subcontractors, who are expected to meet their local employment commitments.
- **Reporting & improvement:** We track Hire & Buy Local outcomes throughout the project to ensure transparency and accountability. We also gather feedback to continuously improve the program.
